Then a Samaritan traveling down the road came to where the hurt man was. When he saw the man, he felt very sorry for him.

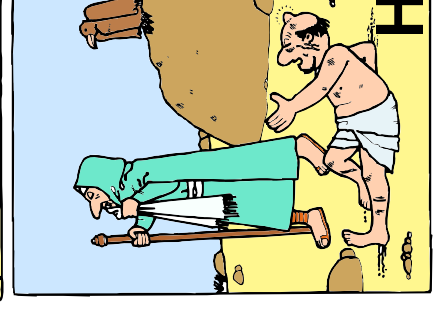
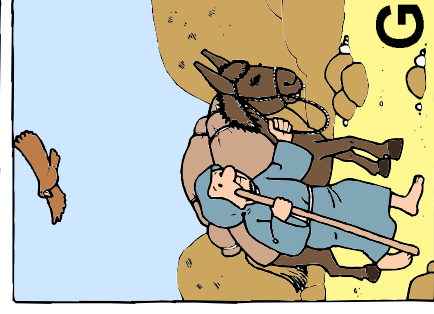
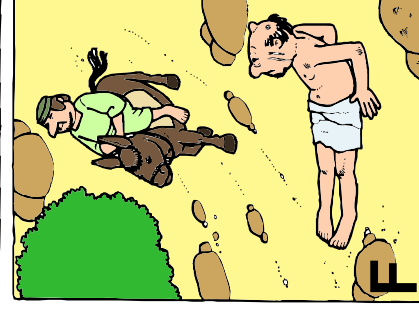
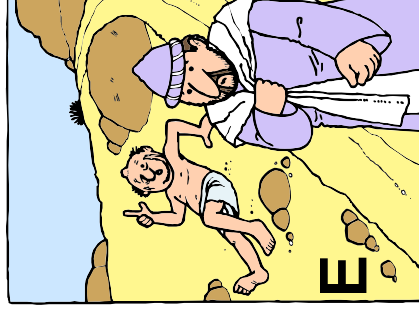
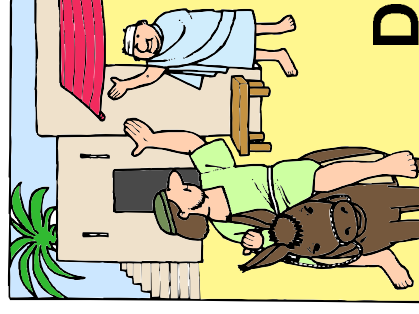
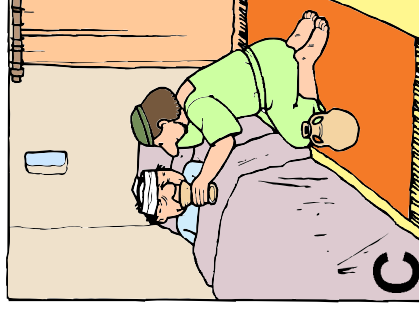
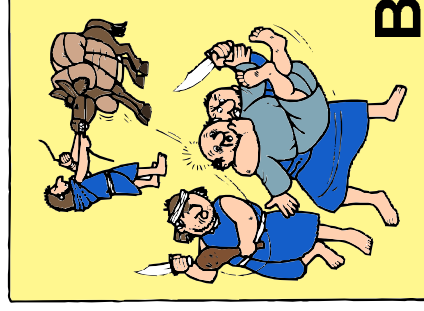
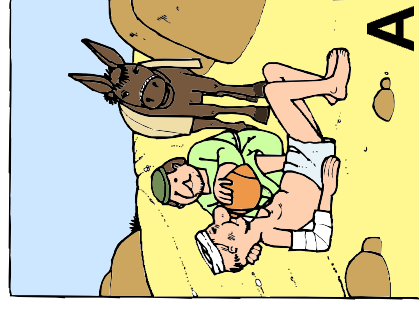
